## Goals and Objectives for all Postprofessional Programs

Goal 1. The program will provide the necessary content and clinical expertise to develop advanced clinical practitioners for patients/clients with Cardiovascular and Pulmonary, Orthopaedic, or Neurologic conditions.

#### Objectives:

- 1. The program faculty will assess on an annual basis the didactic coursework, clinical experiences, and clinical mentoring across practice sites.
- 2. The program will establish and maintain collaborative relationships with clinical partners.
- 3. The program will provide clinical mentoring.

#### Goal 2. The program will support scholarly endeavors for the advanced practice clinician.

### Objectives:

- The residency faculty will collaborate with the Director of Physical Therapy Research for proposal submission.

- 3. The clinical practice site will facilitate the research agenda.

## Goal 3. The program will support the professional development of the resident and fellow-intraining (FIT).
