Goals and Objectives for all Postprofessional Programs

Goal 1. The program will provide the necessary content and clinical expertise to develop advanced clinical practitioners for patients/clients with Cardiovascular and Pulmonary, Orthopaedic, or Neurologic conditions.

Objectives:

1. The program faculty will assess on an annual basis the didactic coursework, clinical experiences, and clinical mentoring across practice sites.
2. The program will establish and maintain collaborative relationships with clinical partners.
3. The program will provide clinical mentoring.

Goal 2. The program will support scholarly endeavors for the advanced practice clinician.

Objectives:

1. The residency faculty will collaborate with the Director of Physical Therapy Research for proposal submission.
2. The University library resources will be available to support the research agendas of the resident and faculty.
3. The clinical practice site will facilitate the research agenda.

Goal 3. The program will support the professional development of the resident and fellow-in-training (FIT).

Objectives:

1. The faculty will provide didactic and experiential growth opportunities in leadership skills.
2. The faculty will strengthen relationships with community partners to support advocacy on individual and societal levels.
3. The faculty will mentor the resident and FIT in teaching.
