Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) Program Application Checklist – Fall 2025 Entering Class

Final Deadline for Complete and Verified PTCAS Applicants: November 15, 2024

All applicants are required to submit the following items by the deadline to make their application complete:

- Primary application must be submitted online via PTCAS: <http://www.ptcas.org>. Official transcripts and GRE scores must be sent to PTCAS. The correct ETS code to send GRE scores to PTCAS is Mercer U Physical Therapy (7750). Submission of at least 3 weeks prior to the deadline is suggested in order to ensure timely receipt of your scores.
- Supplemental application must be submitted online via SurveyMonkey: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/BJV7GFW>
- Supplemental Application fee of \$25 submitted either via the following link or by check or money order to the address at the bottom of this page: <https://mercer.nbsstore.net/college-of-health-professions-physical-therapy-program>
- Three (3) letters of reference must be submitted to PTCAS. At least one letter must come from a practicing Physical Therapist and one must come from a college professor/instructor. The third letter can come from any non-relative professional.
- Documentation of physical therapy observation, volunteer, and/or work experience and community service activities must also be included in the PTCAS application.
- International students or domestic students with credentials from institutions outside the United States are required to have those credentials evaluated by a professional evaluation service. This evaluation must include an analysis of courses, grades and grade point average, and U.S. degree equivalency. Mercer University accepts evaluations from the following service: World Education Services: <http://www.wes.org/>

An official copy of the evaluation report must be sent to PTCAS to be included in the application. Additionally, applicants whose native language is not English must demonstrate satisfactory proficiency in English language as measured by the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). Until this procedure has been accomplished, an application for admission cannot be considered.

NOTE: Please submit required items early. All applications must be complete and verified by the deadline date in order to be considered for the program. Submitting on the deadline will not suffice.
