Withdrawal Policy

ARC-PA Standard A3.14e

Withdrawal

During the didactic or clinical phases, if a student encounters difficulty meeting course objectives or maintaining acceptable grades due to unexpected illness or other significant problems or impairment, IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. The Program Director will meet with the student to discuss the option of withdrawal from the Program/University.

Re-Admission to Program after Withdrawal

A student who withdraws from the Program while in good academic standing may reapply for readmission into the program; however, readmission after withdrawal is not guaranteed. The former student must reapply in its entirety and compete with the cohort of applicants who are also seeking admission to the Program.
