Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Mercer University Physician Assistant students are clearly identified in clinical settings and are distinguishable from other health profession students, faculty, staff, and licensed practitioners.

Policy

Physician Assistant students must be clearly identified during all didactic clinical experiences and supervised clinical practice experiences. Students are required to wear program-approved attire, a Mercer University College of Health Professions white coat, and visible identification, including the Mercer identification badge and/or program-approved name tag, as applicable to the clinical experience or rotation.
